Every day, Wenqi guides his blind friend Haixia around with one **sleeve** of his coat. They work together and act as each other's eyes and arms. Wenqi looks for **branches** on trees. Haixia then climbs up the trees and cuts them off. After climbing back down, Haixia digs holes in the ground to plant the cuttings. Wenqi then waters the new trees.

This perfect pair of friends make a living by helping each other. In the past 10 years, they have planted over 10,000 trees around their **village**.
