## A. Similar-sounding words

As you listen to the four choices, pay close attention to <u>similar-sounding words</u> with different meanings.

(e.g. She's <u>setting</u> the table. Vs. She's <u>sitting</u> at the table.)

## B. <u>Wrong word usage</u>

This type of distractor asks you to identify the correct word. It is a vocabulary item.

(e.g. She's <u>setting</u> the table. She's <u>buying</u> the table. She's <u>wiping</u> the table. She's <u>waxing</u> the table.)
