

**Answer Choice TYPE B: "Personal Pronoun Items" → 20 seconds****Step 1**

First of all, check the four answer choices → If you see four personal pronouns, the question typically asks about the "case" of personal pronouns → Check both the "pre-blank" and "post-blank" structure .

**Step 2**

• If the blank is followed by a noun, choose the "possessive adjective". Otherwise, check the position of the blank, i.e. "subject pronoun", "object pronoun" or "possessive pronoun".

- Words ending in -self or -selves are called 'reflexive pronouns'.

(a) They usually refer back to the subject of the clause. E.g. Jane hates herself. My uncle lives by himself. (=alone)

(b) They can also be used for emphasis. E.g. The manager himself telephoned me.
