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Introduction

This course book teaches you vocabulary that will help you when you take the TOEIC. It includes 40 vocabulary-building lessons with words which frequently appear in the TOEIC.

One of the best ways to improve your vocabulary is to listen and read often. The more words you see, the more you will learn. In this course book you might come across the same words again and again in different contexts. Recognizing a word in different contexts proves that you have familiarized yourself with the word. You will learn these words in contexts that are used on the TOEIC.

I suggest that you learn a word first auditorily (by hearing the word repetitively), then visually (by seeing the word repetitively), and finally kinaesthetically (by writing the word repetitively).

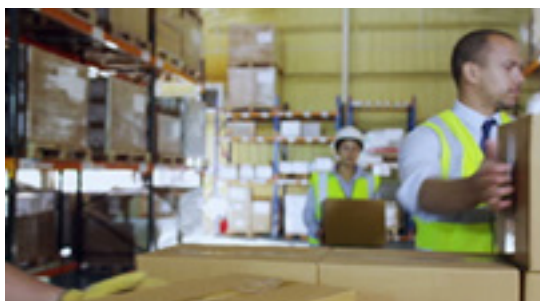
