Ferry

: a boat or ship for conveying passengers and goods , especially over a relatively short distance and as a regular service

The ferry travel saves commuters time and money and this is the local way of life in going to islands. The ferry can fit 15-20 people and passengers can enjoy the full view of some islands. Motorcycle taxi

Cart Bike = Habal Habal

: a motorcycle with extended seat to accommodate more passengers in a row at the rear seat

In fact, because of its extreme popularity among locals and definitely a favorite of foreign tourists, it has now become, as it is rightfully considered, an iconic public transportation particularly in the provinces. Jeepney

: a Philippine jitney bus converted from a jeep

The word **JEEPNEY** is a combination of the words "jeep" and "knee" (from its knee to knee sitting)



Jeepneys are the most popular means of public transportation in Cebu. They were originally made from US military jeeps left over from World War II and are known for their flamboyant decoration and crowded seating.

To board the jeepney, you can either hop aboard when they're stationary (and seeking passengers) or you can flag one down as they drive past. If stationary, they are often at the beginning of the route and will usually not move until it's full or near full. To ask the driver to stop at your destination, you tap a coin repeatedly on metallic rail on the roof.



Motorized Tricycle

: a vehicle similar to bicycle, but having three wheels, two at the back and one at the front



Cebu City is the second biggest city in the Philippines. There are many famous places for tourist. When you arrive in Cebu, you can see some different transportation such as tricycle and jeepney but tricycle is more recommendable mode of transportation if you want to go anywhere in Cebu. Up to 6 or 7 people can sit, plus their luggage. Besides the driver, two people can sit on the outside next to the driver, a couple of people can sit inside the covered side and seemingly at least person is hanging outside the motorcycle.

You can just catch them by waving your hand. Tricycle is very convenient transportation especially when you go to the beaches in Cebu and it also has cheaper price.

Pedal Pedicab (Trisikad)

: a peculiar three- wheeled human powered vehicle



The word "sikad" means kick or pedal, so it's unclear if its meaning comes from pedaling the bicycle or when the driver kicks the foot brake on the front wheel. The brake is one of the most interesting feature of this type of Philippines pedicab as it's simply a foot brake on a sprung hinge over the front wheel, with a piece of car tire used as the brake onto the rubber bicycle tire.

This is used in smaller communities and people will have to ride on "trisikad" to go to main road for them to catch the jeepneys or tricycles. Trisikad is the mode of transportation wherever you go within the towns of Cebu. Foreigners find it interesting so they never miss a chance to ride on it.
