
Chika-an



Pino is a Filipino word meaning "fine"



Pino is the adjective used by Filipinos to express admiration. Pino may refer to "pinong ugali" (fine manners), "pinong burda" (fine embroidery) or "pinong paghahabi" (fine weaving).

In relation to food, pino refers to impeccable preferences as in "pinong panlasa" (fine taste buds). Pino restaurant serves a sumptuous and fine dining experience. It allows the diners to feel the hospitality of traditional Filipinos.
