### **Celestial Gardens**

: located in Banawa Hills, Cebu City which is a memorial park owned and managed by the Tanchan Foundation, Inc.



The park, which is also a garden, is surrounded by various plants and trees. Before you enter, you can see two arches with the statues of two saints on top of the left and right side of the arches. You can feel a sense of tranquility in the place. The life-size statues depict the passion and death of Jesus Christ.

Roman Catholics commemorate Holy Week by visiting Celestial Gardens and praying at every station of the 12 Stations of the Cross. The tradition of meditating and praying is called "The Way of the Cross". A lot of people visit the place, including locals and even foreigners during holy week.

# **Metropolitan Cathedral**

: the first church in the Philippines dedicated to St. Vitalis also known as "The Metropolitan Cathedral of the Most Holy Name of Jesus and St. Vitalis"



The Metropolitan Cathedral was established as a diocese on August 14, 1595. It is devoted to the blessed name of Jesus and dedicated to Saint Vitalis – the patron saint of the church. It took many years to construct the Cathedral because of frequent interruptions such as lacking of funds and other unforeseen events. The Spaniards contributed to the construction and architecture of the church. People go to the Cathedral to worship, to ask for petitions and even to hold wedding ceremonies due to its classical structure.

## **Monastery of the Holy Eucharist**

: located in Simala Sibonga, Cebu which is a very popular church because it is considered to be the home of the image of the miraculous Virgin



Monastery of the Holy Eucharist or commonly known to Cebuanos as "Birhen sa Simala". It is the place where monks live. For the Catholics, Simala is the perfect place to pray for intentions or special wishes in life. In the Monastery, you can see a number of crutches, wheelchairs, and thank you notes from people who have experienced miracles of the Holy Mary. There have been a lot of improvements on the church because of the donations from a lot of people and devotees are increasing. Some people stay in a long line just to have a glimpse and pray to the image of the Virgin Mary. Petitions, prayers and expressing gratitude are also put inside a box.

### Santo Niño Church

: a Spanish word which means "Holy Child of Cebu", located in Osmeña Boulevard, Cebu City and is considered as the oldest Roman Catholic church founded by the Spaniards



The church was built near the place where the Santo Niño was found in the burned house. Destroyed by fire it was rebuilt twice. It was constructed out of hard stone materials. Now the Church is known as the Basilica of Santo Nino in recognition of its importance and that of Cebu City as the cradle of Christianity. Every year, Sinulog Festival is celebrated and it includes the procession of the

image of Santo Niño in the streets, fluvial

procession and street dancing. At present, the Santo Niño image is replicated in many homes and various areas of the country.

## **Taoist Temple**

: located in Beverly Hills Subdivision Lahug, Cebu City with a towering Chinese religious architecture



The Taoist temple is the center of worship for Taoism which was built by the Chinese community in Cebu. The architectural design includes a pagoda-style roof. Both worshipers and non-worshipers can go to the temple.

The devotees perform a ritual where one prays to the gods to grant one's wish. The ritual includes washing of hands, going inside the chapel barefoot and dropping two blocks of wood. If the blocks of wood

are both face up then one could make a wish. If not, then one has to come back to the temple some other time.
