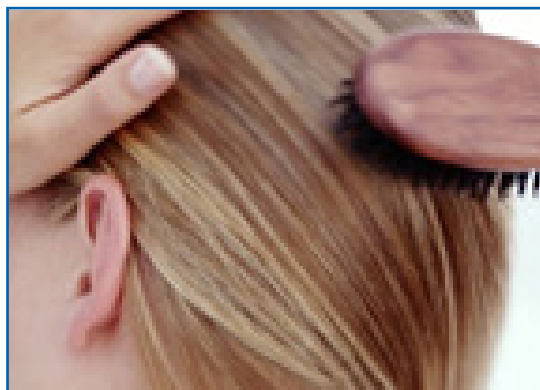

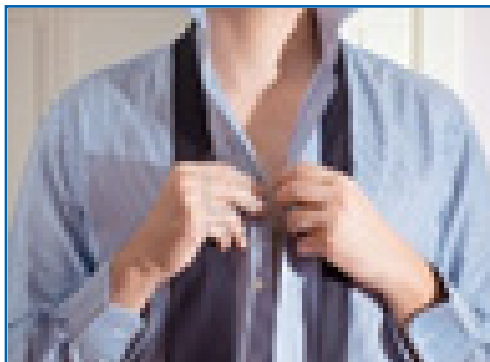
The following steps to explain 'how to blow-dry hair' are not in order. Read the sentences and arrange them into the logical order by writing numbers one through five on the line next to each sentence.
