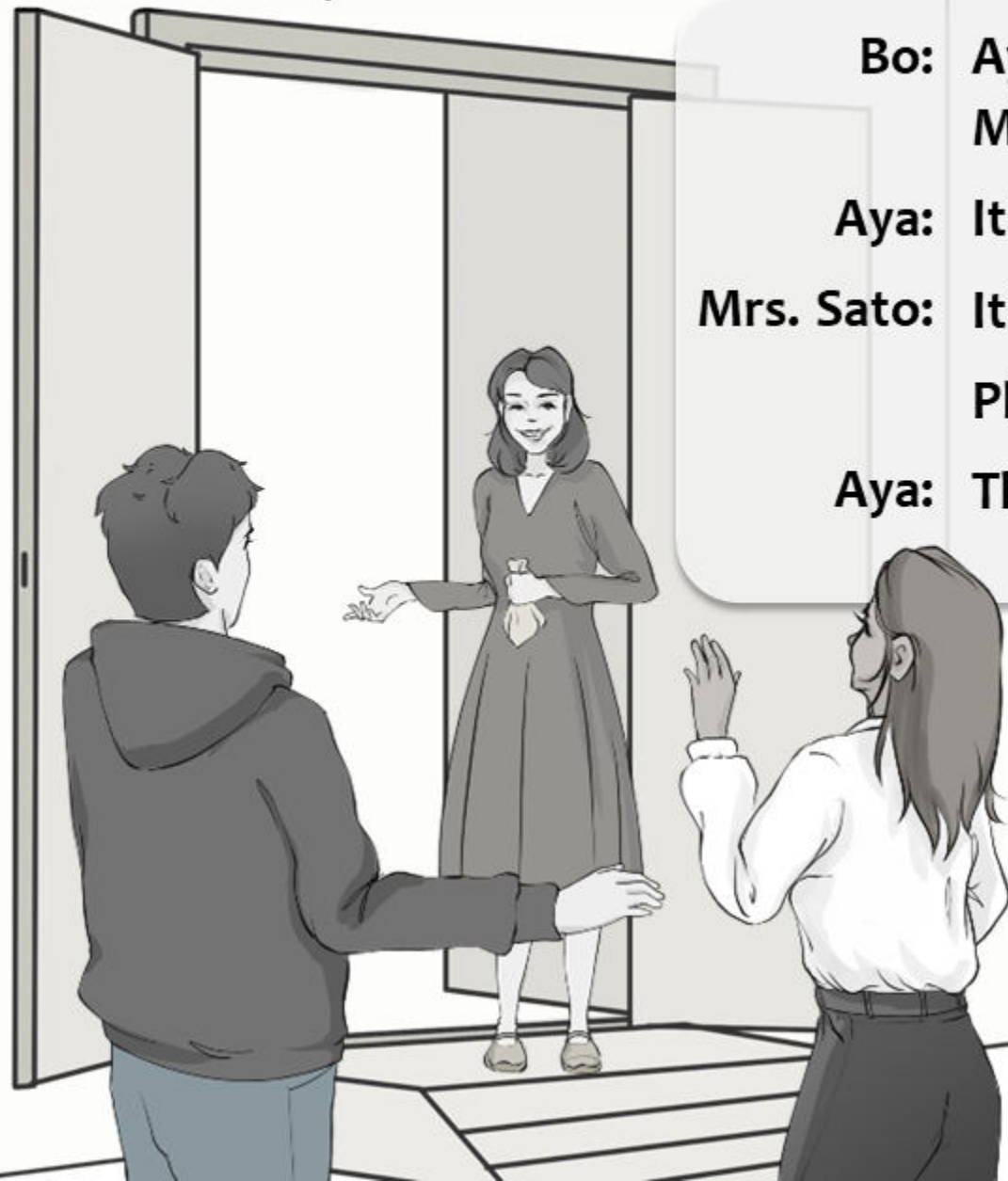

I would (I'd) like = I want

e.g. I'd like you to meet Bella.

(or) I would like you to meet my sister, Bella.

(or) I want you to meet my sister, Bella.

This is - used to introduce a person

e.g. Bella, this is Nikki.

(or) Bella, this is my friend, Nikki.

WHO

a WH-question word used to ask to identify a person.

Who is this? -- This is my dad.

Who is she? -- She is my sister.

Who is he? -- He's my brother.
