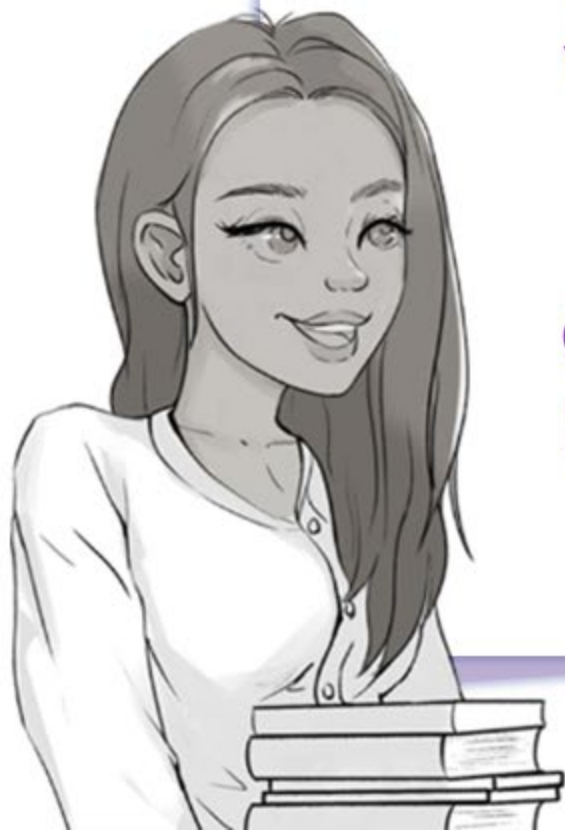

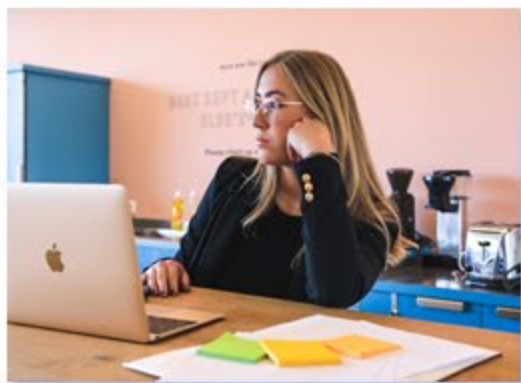

Feeling Adjectives

a word that describe a person's feelings

I am **happy**.

They are **tired**.

He is **thirsty**.

We are **hungry**.

is used to say that you also feel the same thing



I am sleepy.

I am sleepy, **too**.





Learn two types of linking verbs.

Linking Verbs

Type 1: am, is, are

are used to **re-identify** a noun or pronoun

He **is** my brother.
noun

I **am** her sister.

They **are** my friends.

Type 2: look, taste, smell, etc.

are used to **describe** a noun or pronoun

You **look** tired.
