The horse is **fast**. The turtle is **slow**.

The living room is **beautiful**. The kitchen is **ugly**.

The elephant is **big** and the bird is **small**.

Example:

The bird is beautiful. The bird is small.

The bird is beautiful **and** small.

Describing Nouns

We can put an **adjective** before or after a noun.

Before Nouns

It + is + **adjective** + noun

It is a **good** book.

It is a **fast** car.

It is a **slow** car.

It is a **good** cake.

It is a **bad** cake.

After Nouns

The + noun + is/ are + **adjective**

The **book** is **good**.

The **car** is **fast**.

The **car** is **slow**.

The **cake** is **good**.

The **cake** is **bad**.

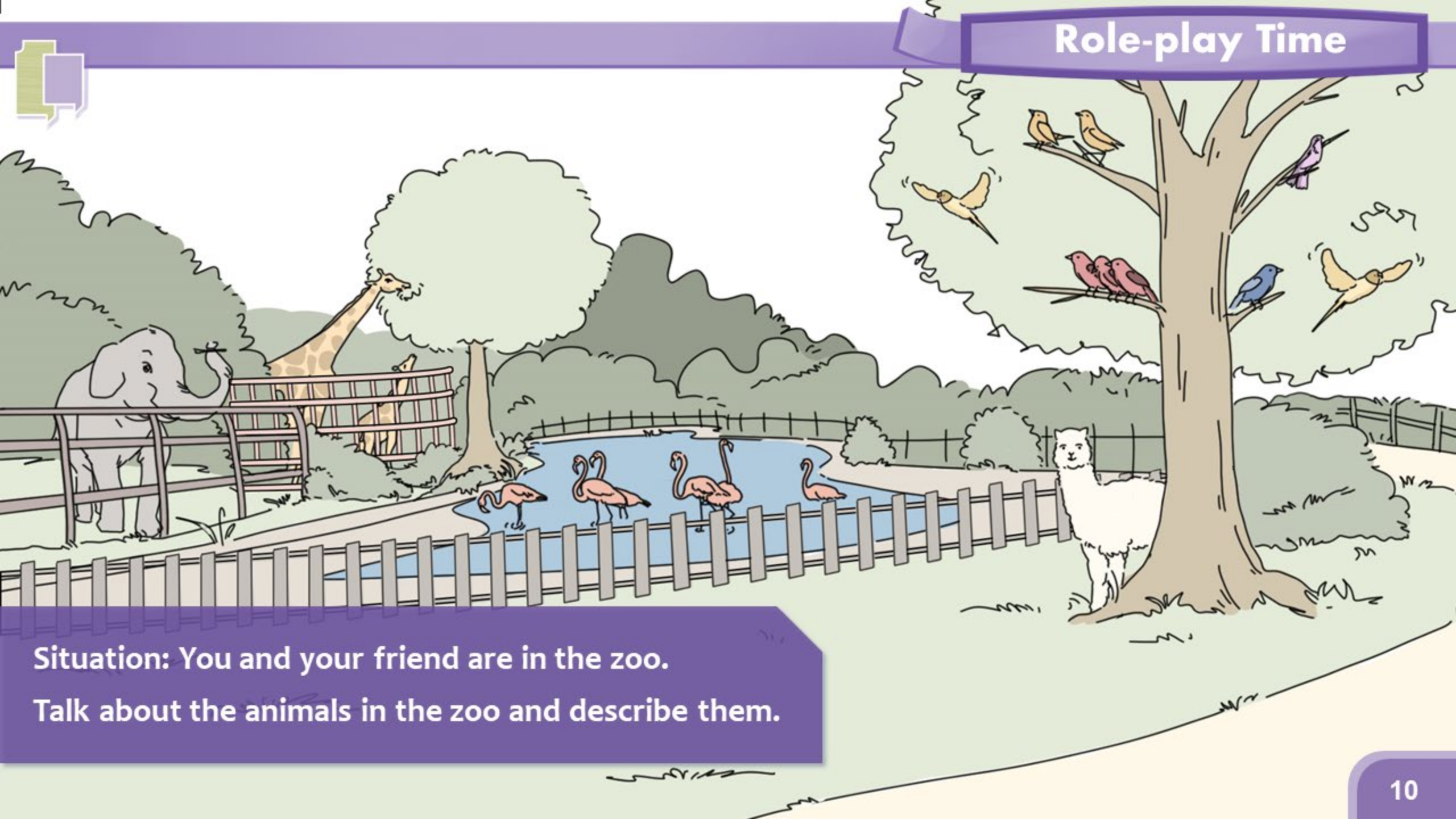
