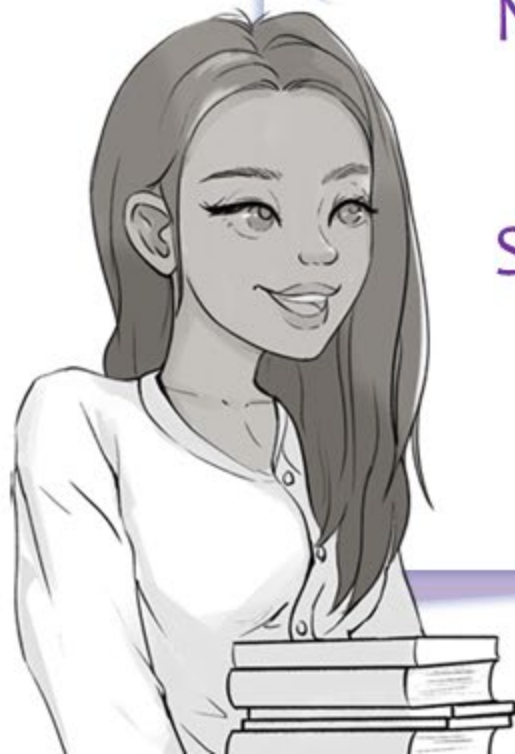

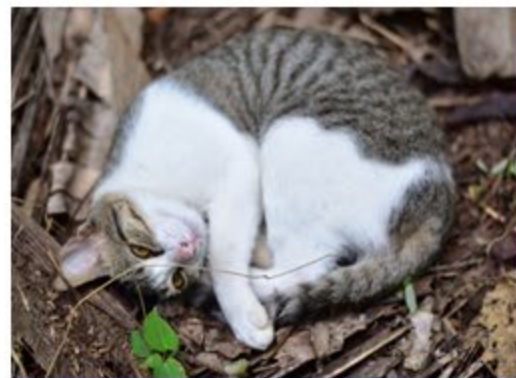

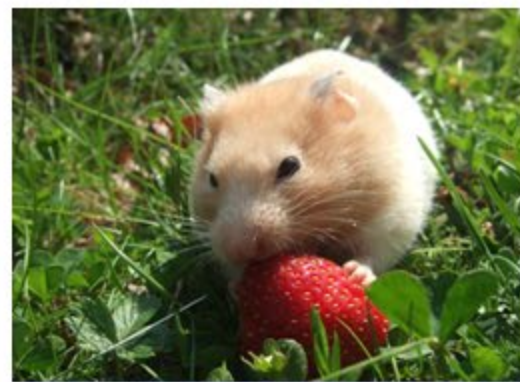

A. Short 'do' Questions and Answers

□ To make 'do' questions

Do + (I, you, we, they) + verb

Do you have a pet?

Does + (he, she) + verb

Does he/ she have a pet?

□ To answer 'do' questions

Yes, I **do**.

No, I **don't**.

Yes, he/ she **does**.

No, he/ she **doesn't**.

but

is used to connect ideas that contrast (when the second phrase does not support the first phrase)

Example:

Girl: Do you have a pet, Leo?

Boy: No, I don't, **but** I play with my neighbor's dog.

B. Present Simple

Persons	Singular (1)	Plural (2 or more)
First	I play	We play
Second	You play	You play
Third	He / She plays	They play

In the **third person** (She/He/It)

1. Most verbs add -s	drink - drinks walk - walks
2. Verbs ending in -s/ -ss/ -sh/ -ch/, add -es	kiss - kisses teach - teaches
3. Verbs ending in -y after a consonant, change 'y' to 'i' then add -es	fly - flies study - studies
4. <i>go, have, and do</i> are irregular	go - goes have - has do - does
