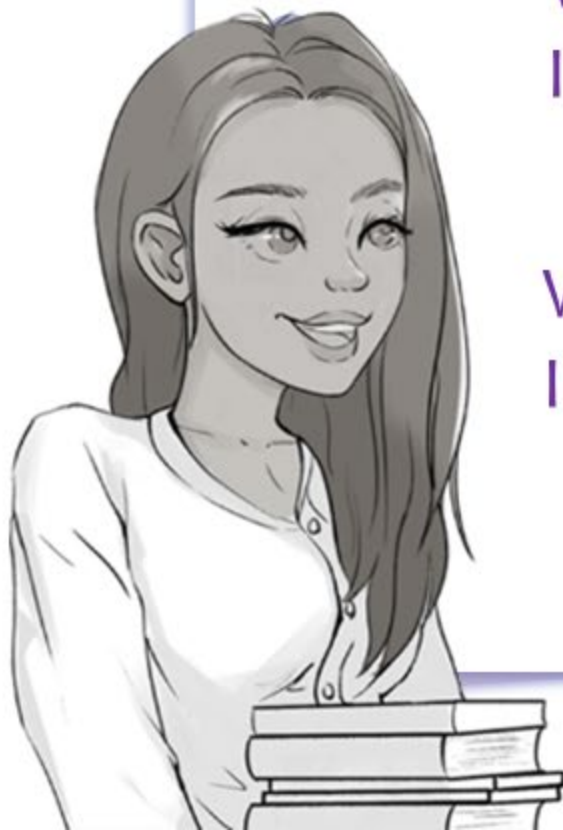

They are from **Japan**.

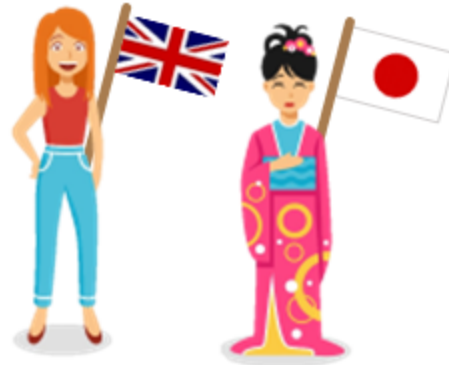
We are from **Thailand**.

- is used to say which country someone belongs to



He is **American**.

She is **British**.

They are **Japanese**.

We are **Thai**.

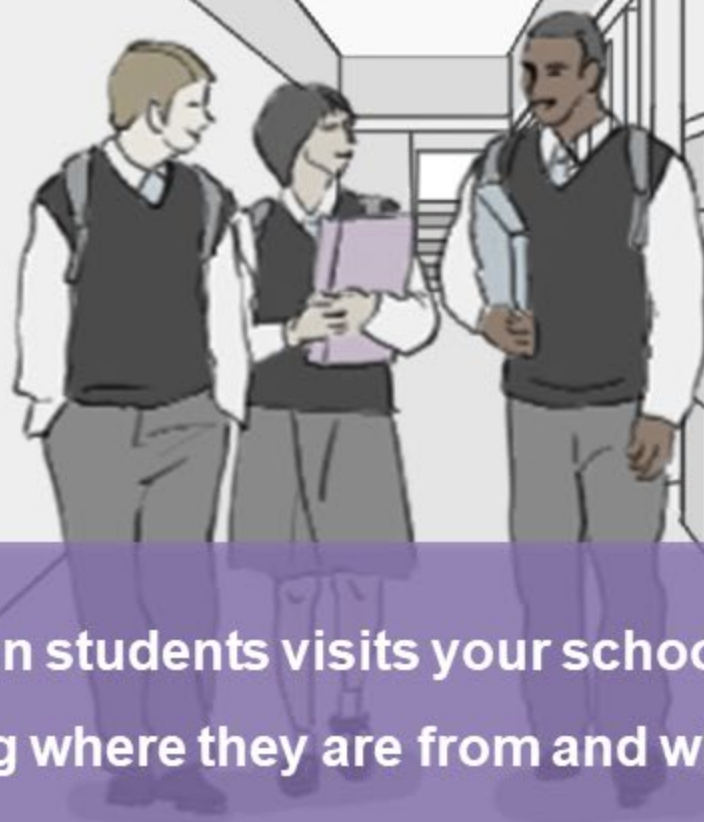
