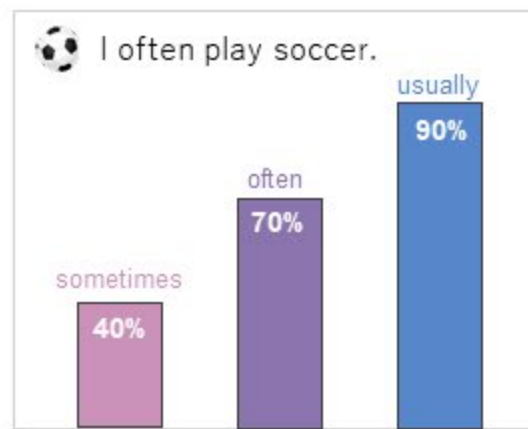

How often do you + **verb**...?

I **always** **play** soccer.

I **usually** **play** basketball.

I **often** **go** to the mall.

I **sometimes** **watch** a movie.

I **never** **eat** vegetables.

Frequency Answer

always	100%
usually	90%
often	70%
sometimes	50%
never	0%

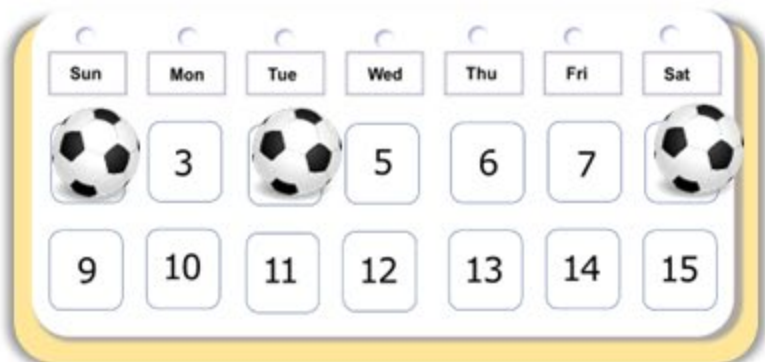

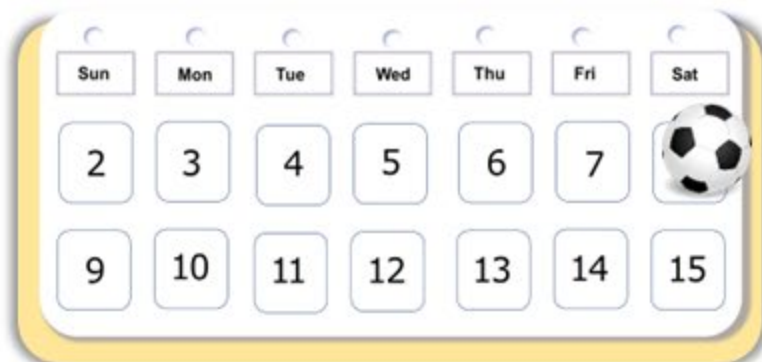

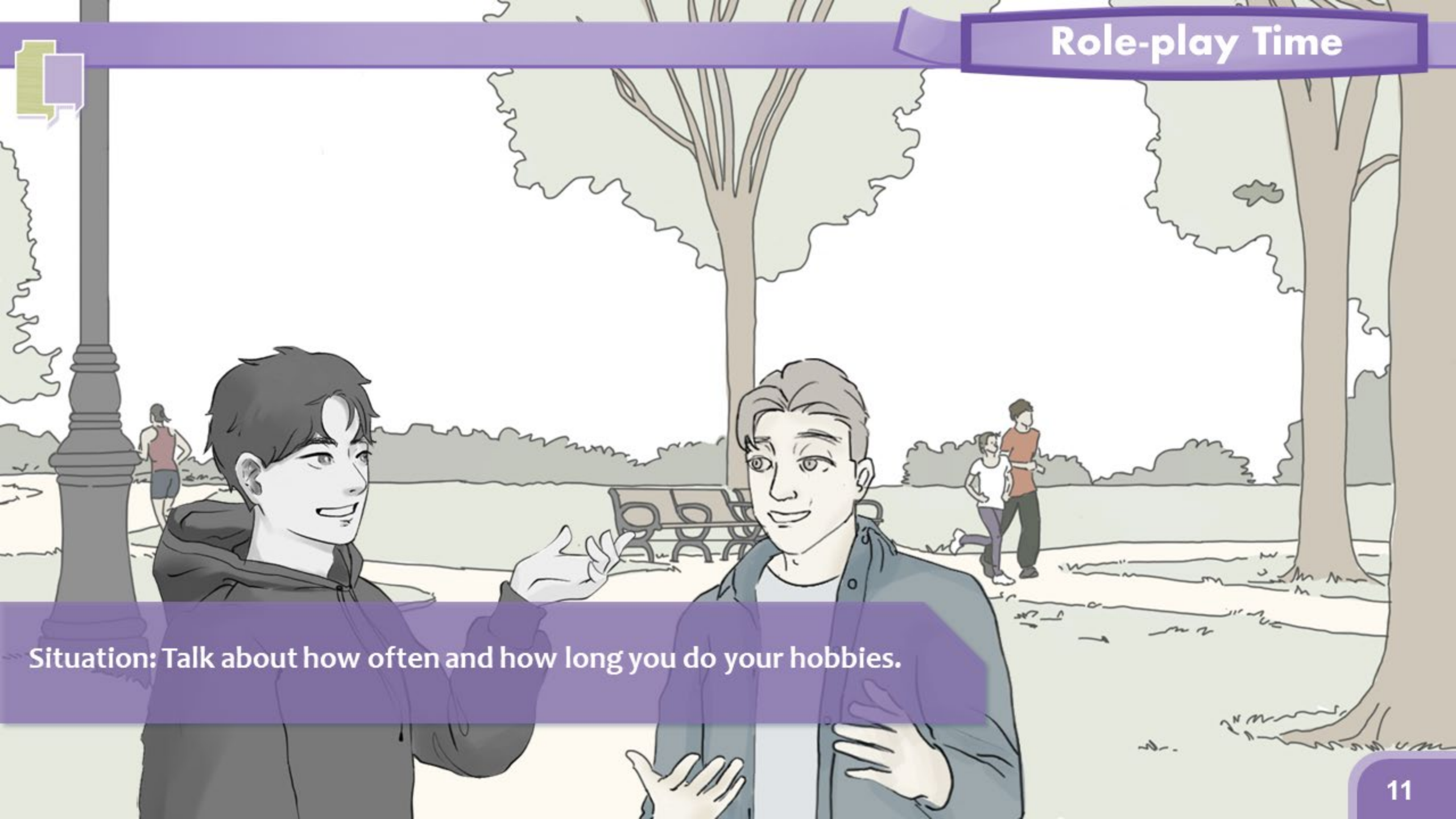
