Q: What day is it tomorrow?

A: Tomorrow is Saturday.

B. on + days

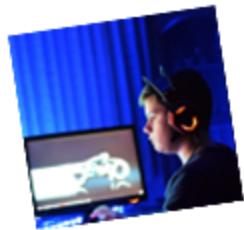
☞ is used for days of the week .
