

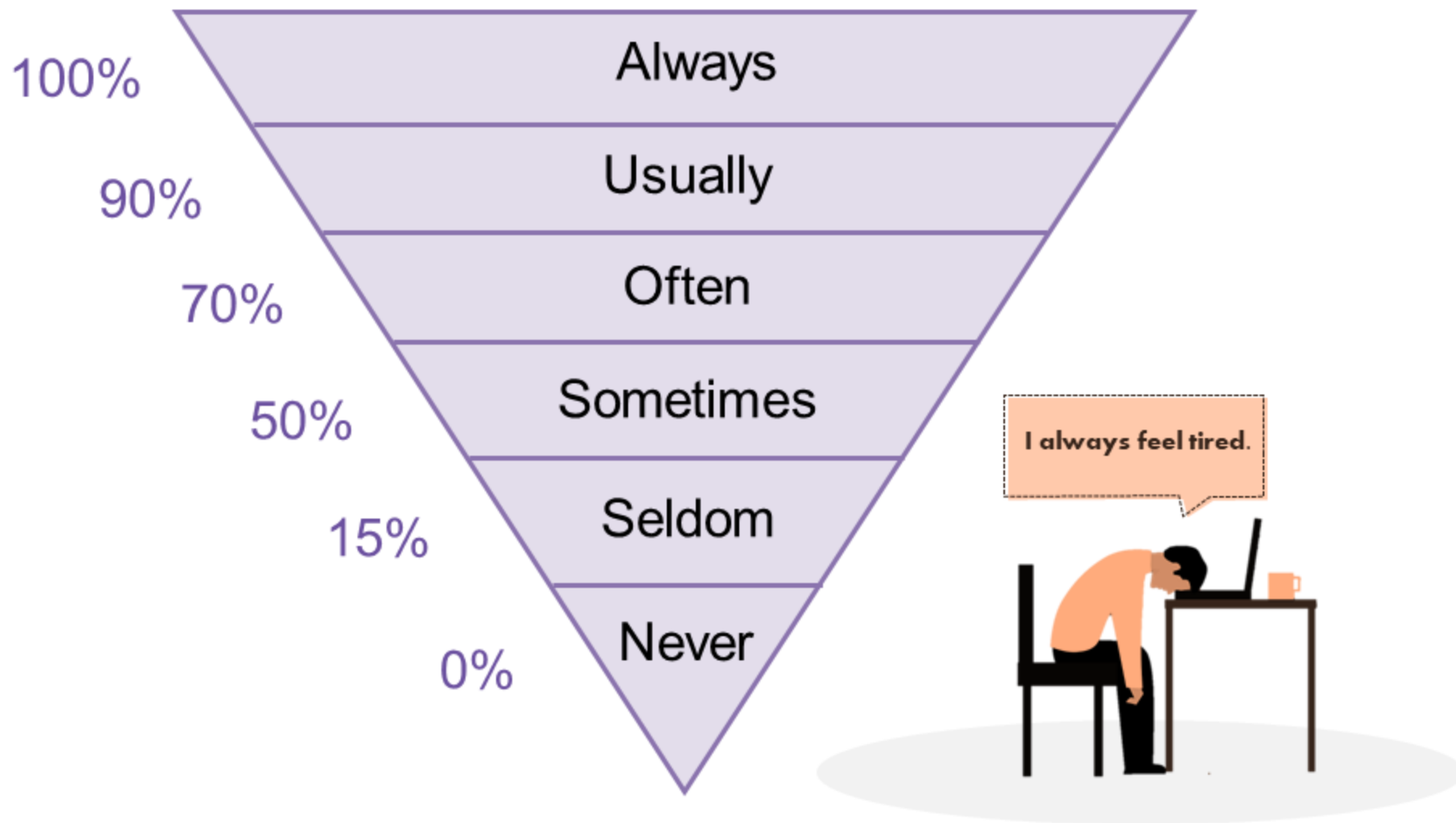

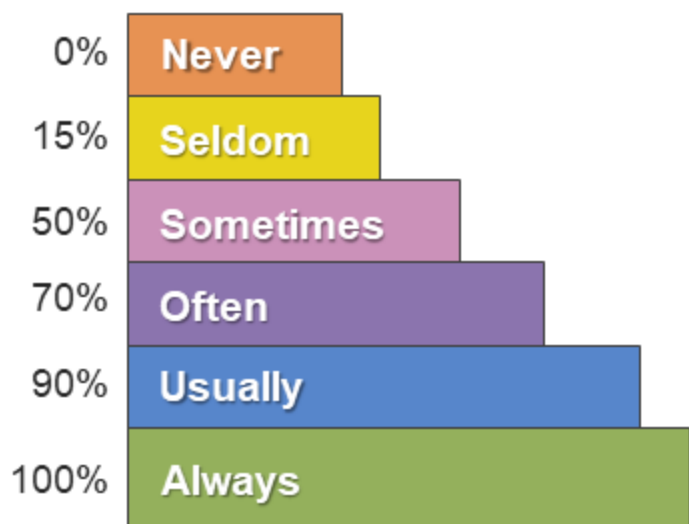

There are **two** ways to use Adverbs of Indefinite Frequency.

- 1 **noun/pronoun** + **adverb (indefinite frequency)** + **verb**

I usually watch TV.

John often plays tennis.

- 2 **noun/pronoun** + **be verb** + **adverb (indefinite frequency)**

They are always dancing.

She is seldom sad.

has exact time or number

I watch TV once a day.

She runs daily.

John plays tennis every two days.

number of times + **a** + **time period**


