



# Uses of the Present Progressive Tense

### Use 1: Actions in progress

- 1. Grandpa is not at home. He is traveling with his friends these days.
- 2. They are working in a factory right now.
- 3. More and more people are giving up smoking at present.
- 4. We are discussing the project at the moment.

What are you doing now? What is your mother doing at this moment?

# **Uses of the Present Progressive Tense**

#### Use 2: Actions in the near future

- 1. I'm leaving for Brussels tomorrow.
- 2. Are you finishing your homework in 2 hours?
- 3. Tim and Sally are starting their online lessons this evening.
- 4. My cousins are arriving in town this Friday.


Note: Only the actions that happen in a second can be used in this way, e.g. coming, and leaving.


