Aya: Do you need my help, Mom?

Mom: It's fine, Aya. What is your father doing now?

Aya: **He is fixing my bicycle.** I need it today.

Mom: Are you hanging out?

Aya: Yes, Mom. **I'm going to the city center this afternoon,** and hanging out with my friends.

Mom: When are you coming back?

Aya: I'll be home before dinner.

Mom: Alright. Get home in one piece.

Uses of the Present Progressive Tense

Use 1: Actions in progress

.....

1. Grandpa is not at home. He is traveling with his friends **these days**.
2. They are working in a factory **right now**.
3. More and more people are giving up smoking **at present**.
4. We are discussing the project **at the moment**.

What are you doing now? What is your mother doing at this moment?

Uses of the Present Progressive Tense

Use 2: Actions in the near future

1. I'm **leaving** for Brussels **tomorrow**.
2. Are you **finishing** your homework **in 2 hours**?
3. Tim and Sally are **starting** their online lessons **this evening**.
4. My cousins are **arriving** in town **this Friday**.

Note: Only the actions that happen in a second can be used in this way, e.g. coming, and leaving.
