\* A gerund is the -ing form of a verb that is used as a noun.

## Gerund vs. Present Participle

**Gerund** – used as a **noun**

He likes **writing** in English.

My family likes **going out** to restaurants.

**Present Participle** – used to form  
the **present progressive tense**

He **is reading** a book.

She **is watering** plants.



## Verbs usually followed by gerunds:

- **enjoy**  
I enjoy watching movies at the cinema.
- **dislike**  
I dislike going to sport competitions.
- **hate**  
He hates waking up early.
- **love**  
I love chatting with my friends.
- **recommend**  
Doctors recommend taking morning walks.



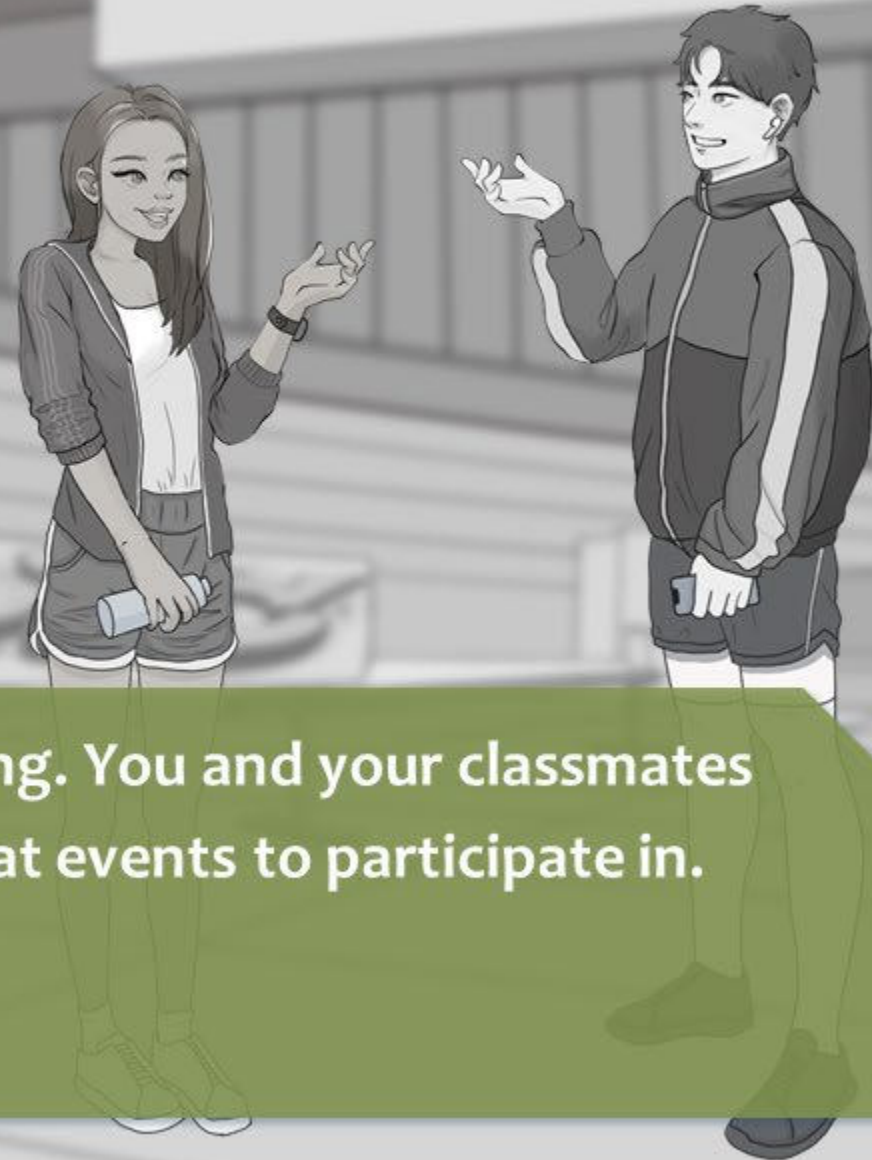
