\* A gerund is the -ing form of a verb that is used as a noun.

#### Gerund vs. Present Participle

#### Gerund - used as a noun

He likes writing in English.

My family likes going out to restaurants.

# Present Participle – used to form the present progressive tense

He is reading a book.

She is watering plants.



#### Verbs usually followed by gerunds:

- enjoy
  - I enjoy watching movies at the cinema.
  - dislike
- I dislike going to sport competitions.

#### hate

He hates waking up early.

- love
  - I love <u>chatting</u> with my friends.
  - recommend
- Doctors recommend <u>taking</u> morning walks.
