

Comparatives

used to compare one thing with another

- 1. I'm taller than you.
- 2. He's shorter than me.
- 3. My son is more musical than my daughter.
- She has darker hair than her sister.
- 5. My car is faster than yours.



Learn the grammar structures.

Rules for Regular Comparatives

• Add -er to one syllable words.

Add –r if it ends in -e.

 Double the consonant if it ends in CVC then add –er.

If it ends in -y, change -y
to -i and add -er.

 For most two-syllable words and for all three or more syllables, use more.

```
expensive – more expensive interesting – more interesting
```


