5. They are going to travel **to the Maldives** for their honeymoon.



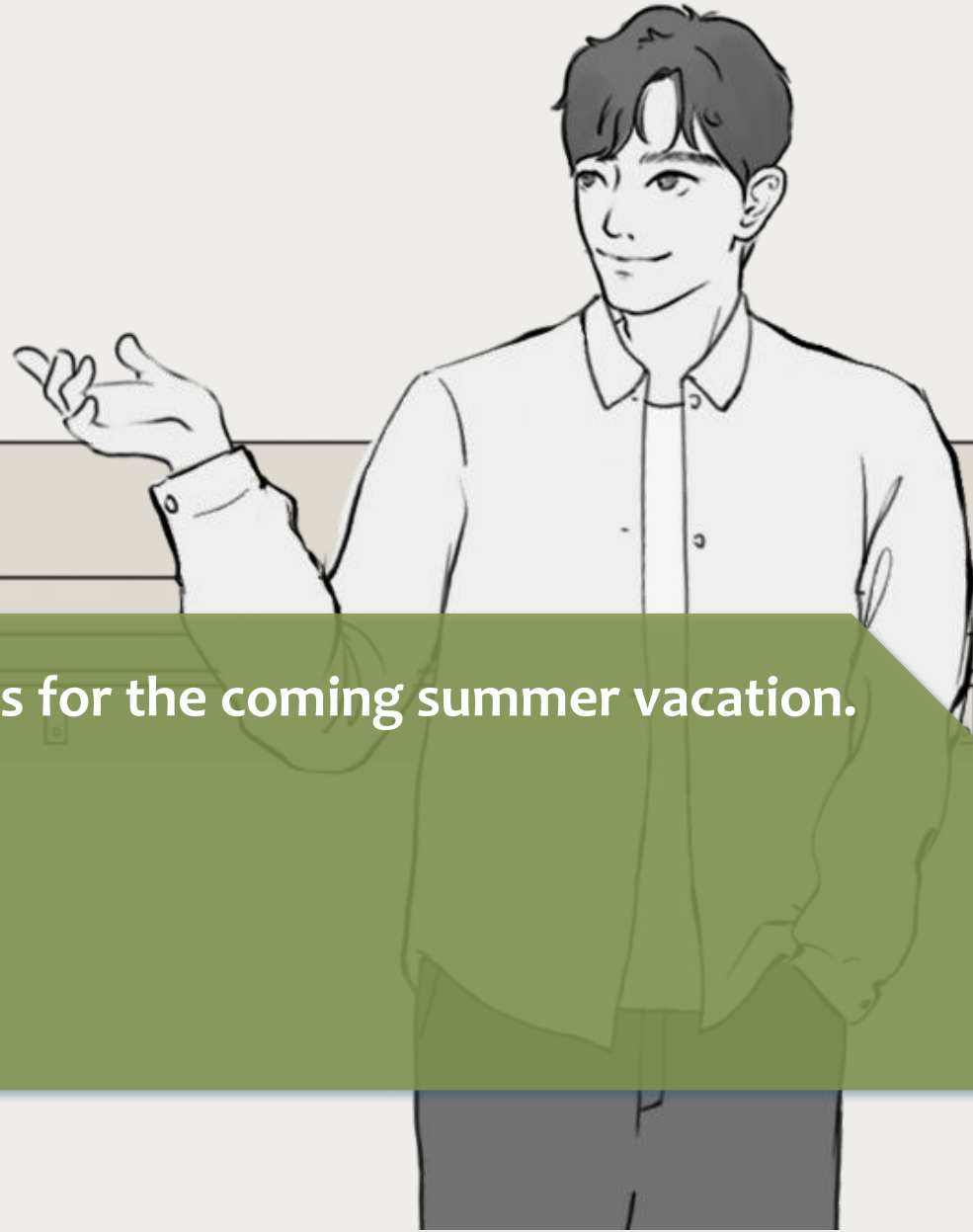
Learn the expression.

comparative + and + comparative

used to show *changes* of a particular quality

Examples:

- I'm feeling *hotter and hotter* as summer is coming.
- Vin's car was going *faster and faster* when he suddenly lost control.
- Everything is getting *more and more* expensive these days.
- I become *more and more* tired as the weeks pass by.
