Dad: No, I didn't. I always water them in the morning.

Aya: Did you forget to do the laundry?

Dad: Of course not! I put them into the washing machine!

Aya: And then?

Dad: I forgot to turn it on!

## Simple Past Tense

used to describe events or actions completed in the past



They **played** soccer at the playground yesterday.



I **attended** a rock concert last night.



I **baked** a cake this morning.

*What did you do yesterday?*

## Spelling Rules of Regular Verbs in the Simple Past Tense

- Add **-ed** to most verbs.

jump – jumped

paint – painted

- If a verb of one syllable ends with [consonant-vowel-consonant], **double** the final consonant and add **-ed**.

chat – chatted

stop – stopped

- If the verb ends with a consonant + y, change 'y' to 'i' and add **-ed**.

cry – cried

fry – fried

- If the verb ends with **-e**, add **-d**.

dance – danced

thrive – thrived

## Simple Past Tense

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?

Question

Did he start doing his homework? Did they dance at the prom last year?

+

Positive

Yes, he *started* doing his homework.

Yes, they *danced* at the prom last year.

-

Negative

No, he *didn't* start doing his homework.

No, they *didn't* dance at the prom last year.

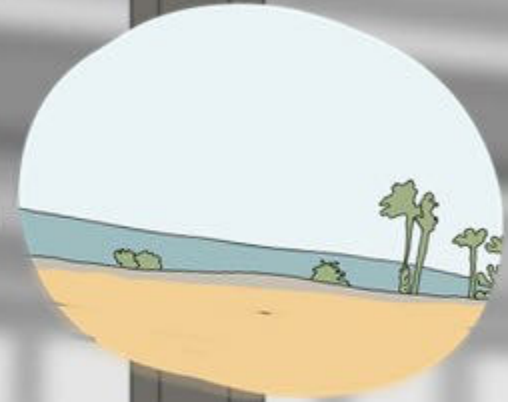
