Esta politely agreed and **she was already drifting off after taking some medicines.** The next morning, she was still feeling unwell and had to rest at home.

- **While** and **When** are
- conjunctions related to the past.

while + long action (Past Continuous)

Jim was driving **while** his sister **was watching** him from the sidelines.

While they **were relaxing** at the hotel, we were preparing for the party.

when + short action (Past Simple)

I was making dinner **when** my mom **called** on the telephone.

When Jane **announced** that she is pregnant, they were cheering loudly.

Adverb Placement

adverbs are placed after the past form of “be”

- She was **already** drifting off after taking some medicines.

- Grandma was **always** telling us funny stories about her youth.

- They were **constantly** arguing during high school.

- I was **just** studying when you came in.

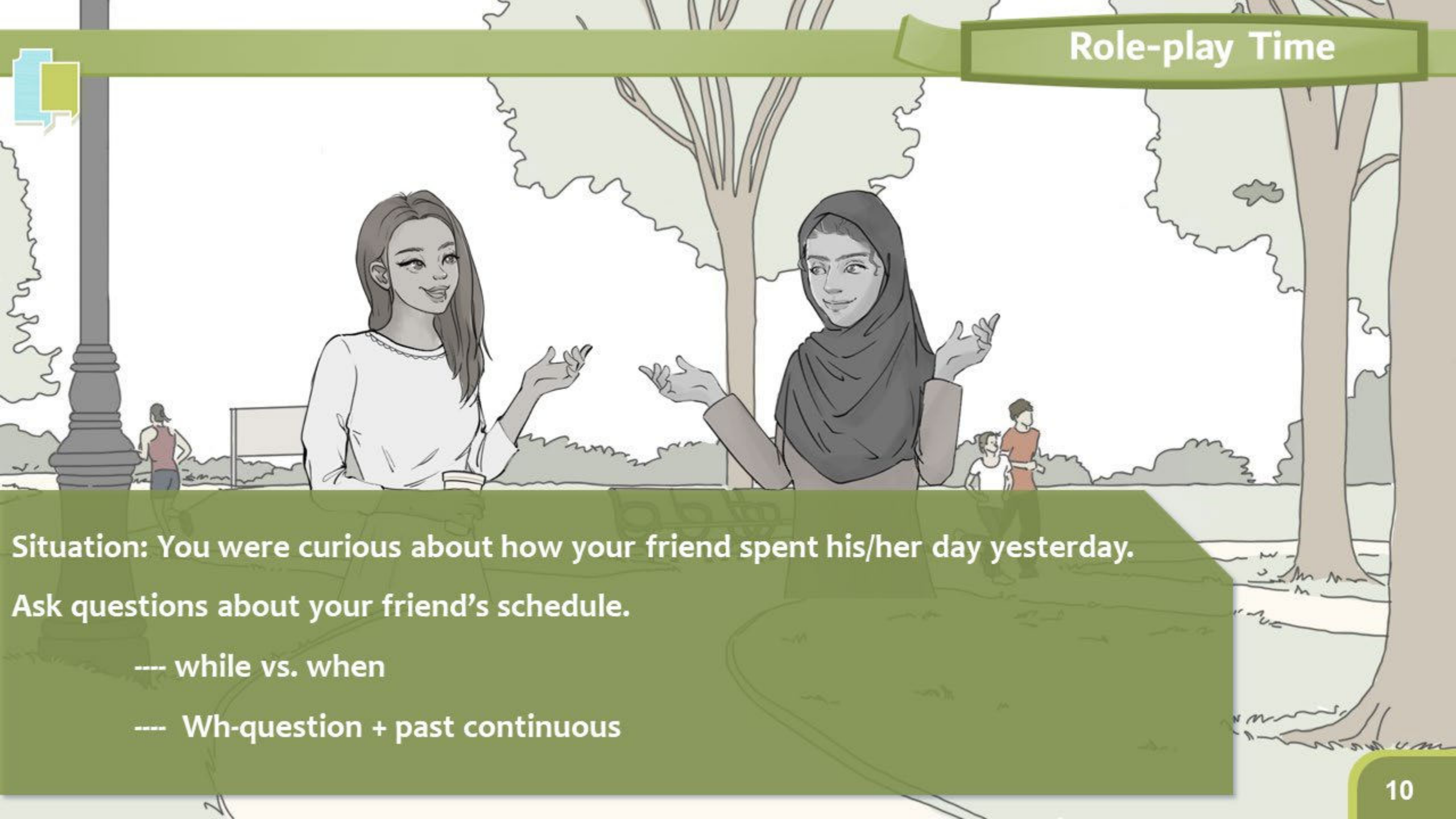
