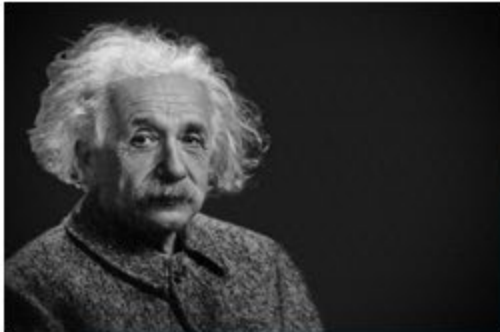

Aya: Perhaps. I'm not sure, though.

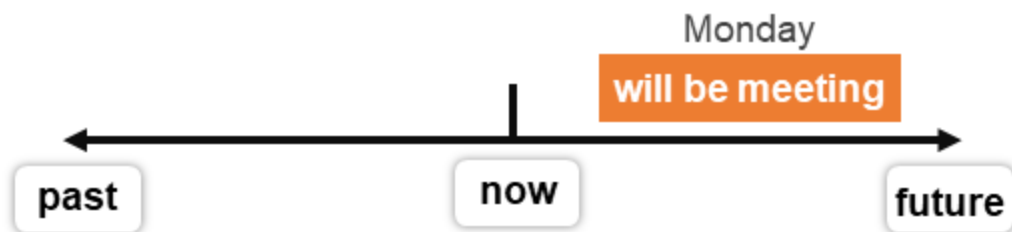

Future Progressive

Used to express a continuing action in the future.

will be + verb-ing



- +** I **will be meeting** some VIPs on Monday.
- I **will not be meeting** some VIPs on Monday.
- ?** **Will** you **be meeting** some VIPs on Monday?

Aya **will be coming** home late tonight.

The team **will not be joining** the game in June.

They **will be performing** on stage next month.

Time Markers

Time markers can be placed at the **beginning** or at the **end** of the sentence.

- **Tomorrow morning**, I will be flying to California.
- I will be flying to California **tomorrow morning**.

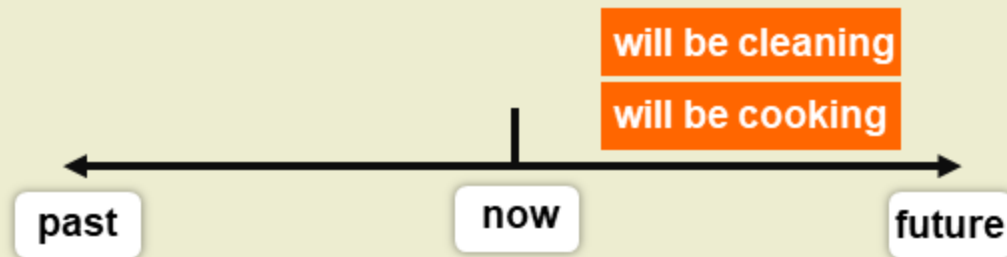

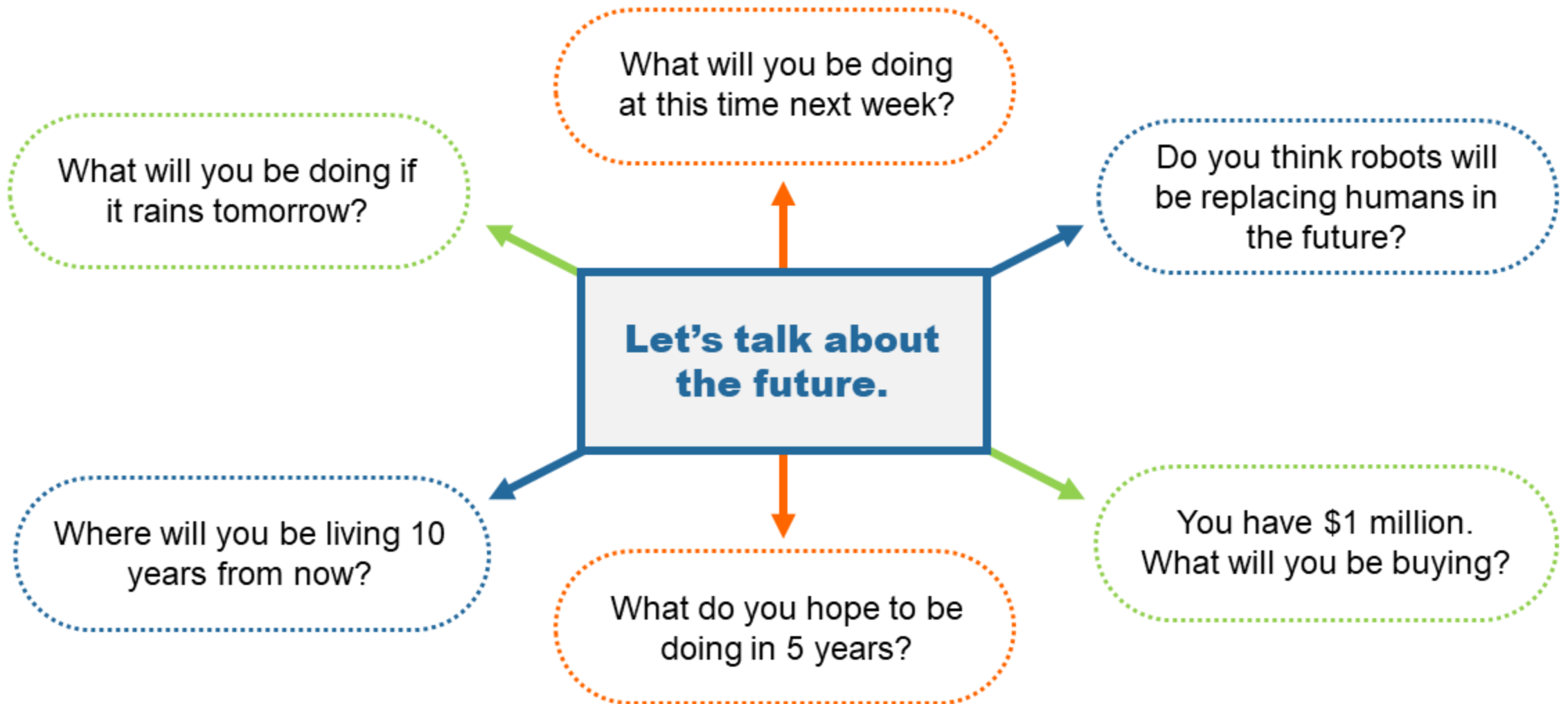
