

## **Progressive Verb Tenses**

is used to refer to an action or a state that is continuous
 also called as Continuous Tenses.

Present Pro	gressive '	Tense
-------------	------------	-------

am/is/are + verb-ing

**Past Progressive Tense** 

was/were + verb-ing

**Future Progressive Tense** 

will be + verb-ing

## **Present Progressive Tense**

is used to talk about actions that is in progress now

### am/is/are + running/not running

- He is running to school.
- He is not running to school.
- !s he running to school? --- Yes, he is. / No, he isn't.

#### other examples:

I am reading my favorite book.

They aren't playing cards.

Are they washing the dishes?

## **Past Progressive Tense**

is used to talk about actions that was in progress in the past

### was/were + writing/not writing

- She was writing a letter.
- She was not writing a letter.
- Was she writing a letter?
  --- Yes, she was. / No, she wasn't.

#### other examples:

They were taking a bath.

We weren't climbing the mountain.

Were they eating pizza?

### **Future Progressive Tense**

is used to talk about actions that will be in progress

### will be + writing/not writing

- 1 will be baking some cookies.
- I will <u>not</u> be baking some cookies.
- Will I be baking some cookies?

--- Yes, I will. / No, I won't.

#### other examples:

She will be singing a song tomorrow.

We won't be going to the cinema.

Will he be cooking dinner tonight?
