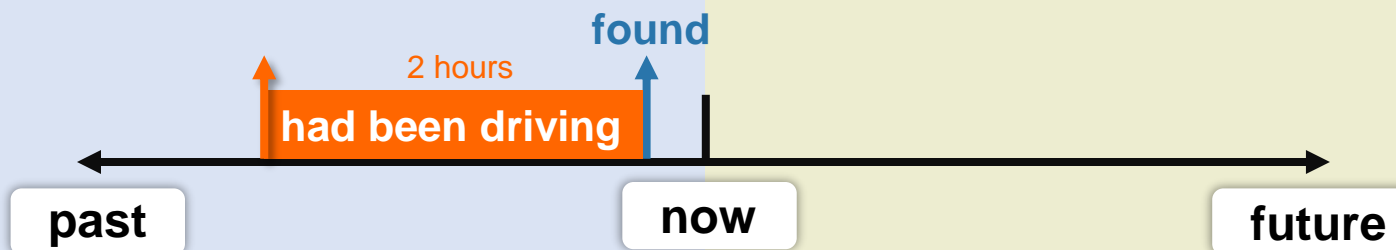

Past Perfect Progressive

Past Perfect Progressive is used to emphasize the duration of an action that was completed before another action or event in the past.



She **had been driving** around the city for two hours when she finally **found** the office.



Aya **had been taking** a nap for longer than an hour when the door opened.

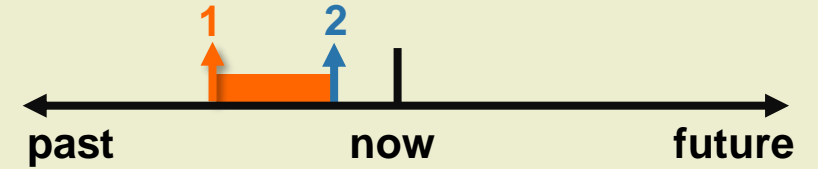
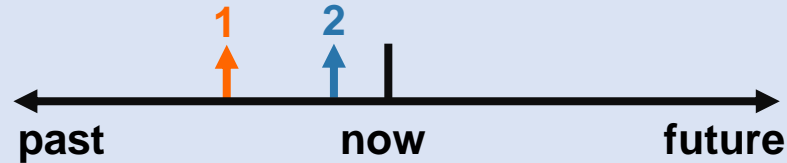
He **had been looking** for Aya before he went inside the nap pod.

Action 1: had + past participle
Action 2: simple past

Action 1: had + been + -ing verb
Action 2: simple past

Use

The first past action **finished** before the second past action.

The first past action is **continued** until the second past action.

Time Markers

by the time, when, before

by the time, when, before

They **had worked** on the project **by the time** they went home.

They **had been working** on the project for six hours **by the time** they went home.

He **had looked** for Aya **before** he went inside the nap pod.

He **had been looking** for Aya **before** he went inside the nap pod.

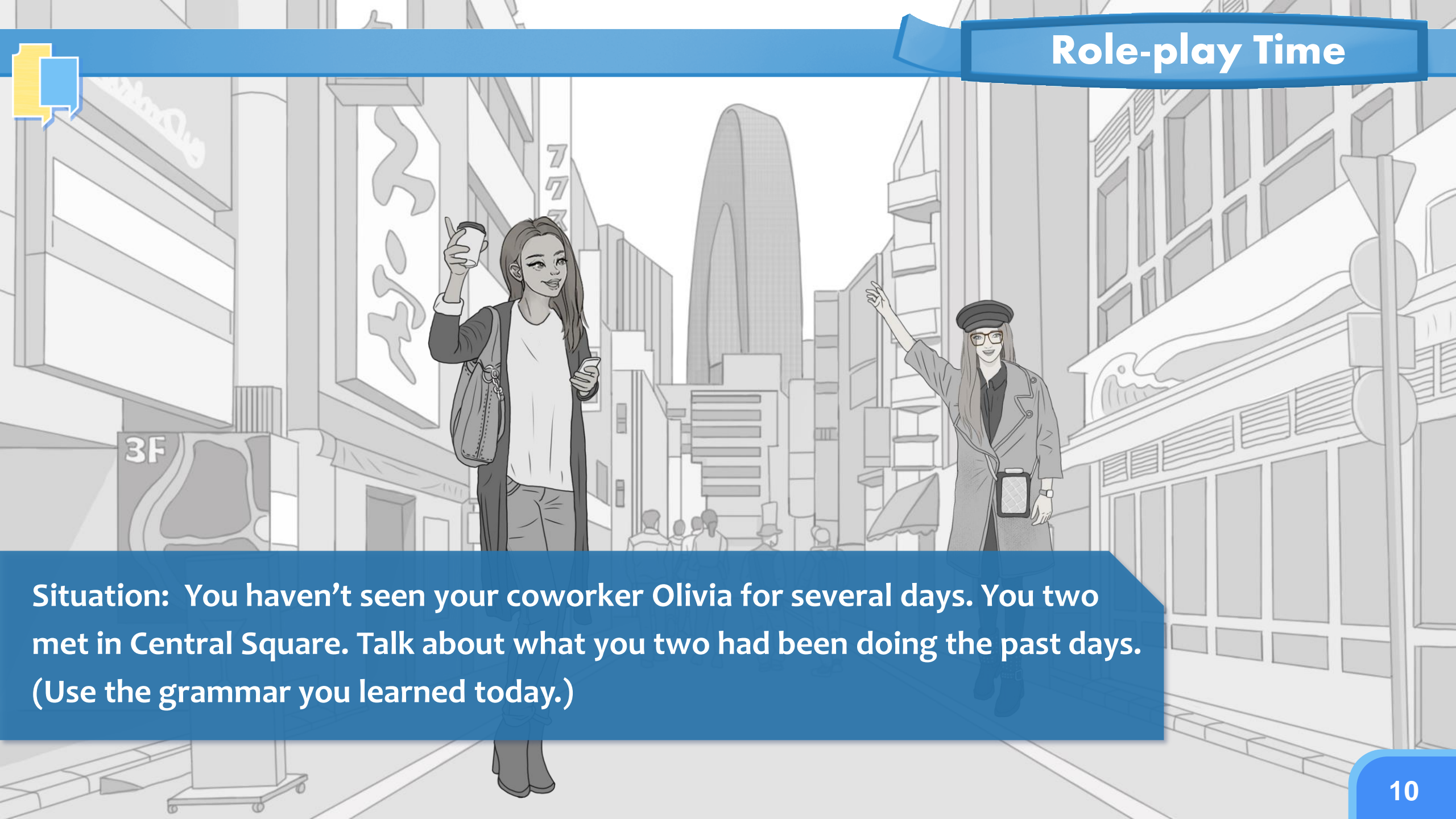
