# Future Perfect Tense

Used to express something that will be finished before a particular time in the future.



will have + past participle He will have done the report by this evening.

will + subject + have+ past participle
Will he have done the report by this evening?

Will not + have + past participle
He won't have done the report by this evening.

Other examples:

We will have moved to our new home **by next week**. She won't have finished the task **by next month**.

Will she have worked at this company by 2026?

## by + time

#### by + time

- something happened before a specific time in the future.

By next week, we will have set some new strategies.



# Future Perfect Tense

Usage 1

To express an action, which will have been finished before a particular time in the future.

Examples:



By 4'oclock, I will have **finished** my work.

She will have **gone** to the market by 7 o'clock.

# Usage 2

To express an action, which will be finished before another action in the future.



She will have **cooked** dinner by the time we **arrive**.

I will have **finished** eating dinner by the time she **calls**.

# Usage 3

To express an action, which began before and will continue up until another action in the future.

Examples:



By next week, we will have been married for 20 years.

By tomorrow, I will have **worked** in this company for 5 years. Supply the correct form of the verbs between the brackets. Use the future perfect tense.
