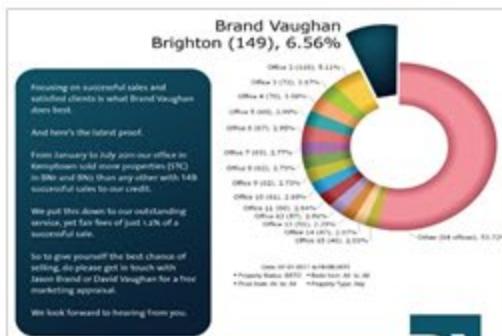

Learn the adjective position.

Adjective Position

Adjectives can be placed before the nouns they modify or after linking verbs and “sense” verbs.

Attributive Position

- Adjectives are placed before the noun.

The **old man** is strolling in the park.

This **clever boy** wants to be a scientist.

We have an array of **portable refrigerators**.

Predicative Position

- Adjectives are placed after the noun and following a verb.

This **part** of the sea is **dangerous**.

Your **computer** looks **expensive**.

The **trip** was **enjoyable**.

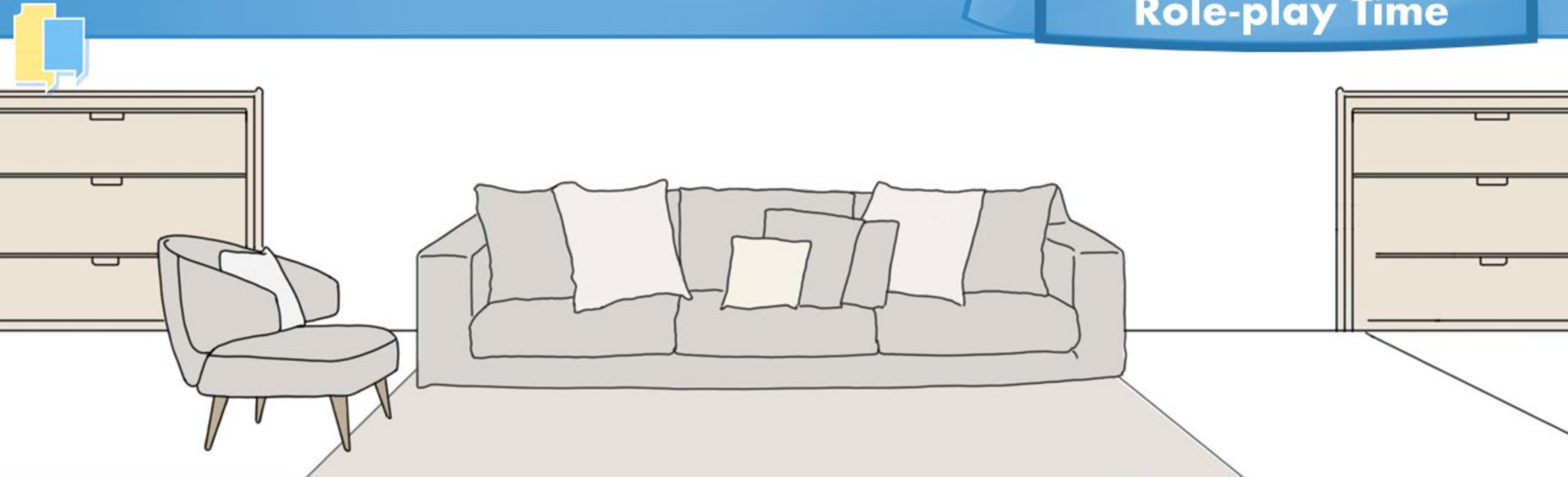
