is a participial phrase that has its own subject.

Original Sentences

Since deadlines are coming,
I should not waste my time.

As life is short, we should
live it to the fullest.

Reduced Sentences

Deadlines **coming**, I should
not waste my time.

Life **being** short, we should
live it to the fullest.
