# **Read and Review**

Poverty means that there is little or no money to meet basic needs such as food, water, clothing and shelter.

There are two types of poverty - absolute poverty and relative poverty.

**Absolute poverty** is a condition where household income is below a necessary level to meet basic needs of life including food, shelter, education, safe drinking water, etc.

**Relative poverty** depends on the level of development of the country. It is a condition where the household income is a certain percentage below median incomes.

household income money received in a family, especially on a regular basis Percentage a rate, number, or amount in each hundred. Median situated in or extending toward the middle


