

- ✓ Protection from preventable diseases;
- ✓ Access to health care and quality medical services;





#### Mother and child health

Nowadays, the health of mother and child has become a growing concern. Based on the data from **WHO**, it is said that 2.8 million pregnant women and newborns die every year.

In 2016, 2.6 million children died in the first month of life. They didn't have quality care and skilled treatment. What's more, poor nutrition causes 45 % of the child deaths under 5 yeas old.



Mothers and newborns face huge risks of death during and after delivery.




#### **Epidemic diseases**

Disease is also one of the factors that affect people's health.

AIDS is now the leading cause of death among teenagers

(aged 10–19) in Africa and the second most common cause
of teenagers' deaths in the whole world.

32.7 million people have **died** from AIDS-related illnesses since the start of the epidemic.



They are transmitted mainly through air containing viruses.







#### Health care and medical services

Many countries are still in the poor medical services such as Syria, Brazil and India. They don't have enough medical supplies and even health care workers, which also causes many health risks.

People suffered a lot under the poor medical conditions.




Lack of medical supplies




