### **Read and Answer**

In the past 10 years, major progress has been made in access to education. However, there are still many children who do not go to school.

More than 140 million did not have the possibility to take the school-leaving examination. Eventually, they were not **qualified** to enter higher education or to graduate from school.

Some 750 million young people (over 15 years of age) are illiterate, and almost two thirds of them are women.

## qualified

having passed the exams or completed the training that are necessary in order to do a particular job

#### illiterate

(of a person) not knowing how to read or write


