### gender pay gaps

Gender pay gap refers to difference between average hourly earnings for men and women.

#### economic inequality

Economic inequality refers to disparities among individuals' incomes and assets.



## Facts about global wealth

- 1. Around 56.6% of people own less than \$10,000, which makes up only 1.8% of global wealth.
- 2. Around 32.6% of people own between \$10,000 to \$100,000, which makes up 15.5% of global wealth.
- 3. Around 9.8% of people own between \$10,000 to \$1,000,000, which makes up 38.9% of global wealth.


