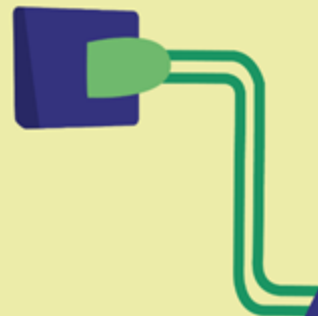

Population

Food Supplies

Energy Issues
