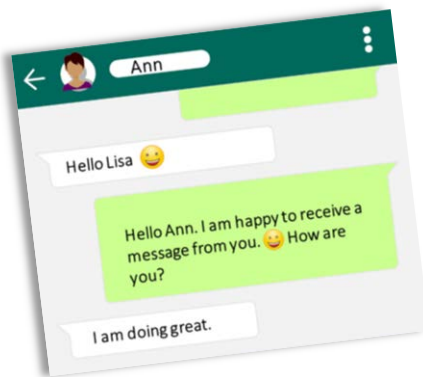

Emojis as the New Language

Emojis are tiny pictures we use in **text messages**. They are a quick way of **communicating** an emotion or idea. In fact, these little pictures make **texting** so fun that they have become a part of our everyday life.



text message – a short written message

texting – making a message by phone



communicate – to share information

Read and learn.

The word “emoji” comes from two Japanese words. “E” means a picture and “moji” means a **character**. They were created in 1998 by a Japanese engineer. They started **taking off** in 2010 and then became the fastest growing language.

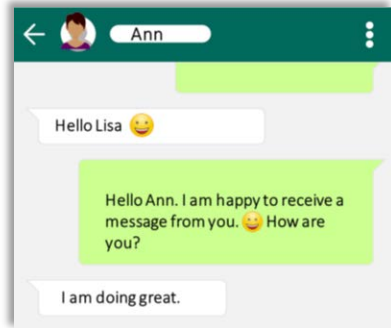
