

The Only Male to Give Birth

Seahorses are one of the most fascinating creatures in the sea. They look like a tiny horse with a long curled tail. They are actually fish, but they do not have scales.



seahorse



Scales are small thin plates that cover the bodies of fish and other animals.



There are around 40 kinds of seahorses. They live in warm coastal waters. They swim slowly, up and down among the sea plants. They like to tie themselves to the sea plants with their tails.



coastal
= at the land
near the sea
or ocean

Seahorses use their very thin, long snouts to find and eat food. They eat small shrimp and tiny fish. They eat their food whole because they don't have any teeth. They don't have a stomach either.



snout
= the front
part of an
animal's head
that sticks out

The male seahorse is the only male to give birth to babies on the Earth. Once a male and a female seahorse become a couple, they stay together for life. To have babies, the female lays her eggs into the male's pouch. Once the babies are born, they are on their own.



pouch

= the pocket of skin on an animal's stomach where its baby grows

Seahorses have wonderful eyesight. They can look up and down at the same time.

Seahorses are also a master of camouflage.

They can quickly change color to match their surroundings.

Do you think the seahorse is a cool animal?


