More Manners to Remember

When you are **out and about**:

- If you **bump into** someone, say “excuse me.”
- Cover your mouth when you cough or sneeze.
- When you go through a door, hold it open for the person who is behind you.
- Don't push through people to get to the front. Wait for your turn.

out and about

- travelling out or around



bump into

- to hit someone by accident or chance

Read and learn.

- Speak quietly on **public transport**.
- Don't eat on public transport.
- Don't be a **litterbug**!
- Don't stop to talk in the middle of the street. Move to one side.



public transport

- system of buses, trains etc.
(People use it to travel from one place to another.)



litterbug

- someone who throws waste everywhere

Read and learn.

When you are with other people:

- Don't **interrupt** when people are speaking.
- Use people's names when you talk to them.
It makes them feel special.
- Look at someone in the eye when you speak to them. It shows you are interested.
- Don't make fun of other people.



interrupt

- to talk while
others are talking

Read and learn.

- Don't talk about what people look like. But you can say nice things about how people look.
- Don't **whisper** to a friend when you are with other people.
- Don't ask how much something **costs**.



whisper

- to speak in a low voice



cost

- If something costs a certain amount of money, you need to pay that amount to buy it.
