Queen Elizabeth II

Queen Elizabeth II, the queen of Britain, is also the queen of New Zealand, Australia and Canada.

The Queen was born on the 21st of April, 1926. She became queen in 1953.

She is the longest **ruling** queen. She has been **served** by 14 UK **Prime Ministers**.

serve

= to work to give aid or help



Prime Minister

= the head of a government

The Queen is the **head of state** in the UK, but the **Parliament** and the Prime Minister run the country.

Her husband is Prince Philip. They got married in 1947. They live in Buckingham Palace. It is a large house with 775 rooms.

= the leader of the country



Parliament

= the group of people to make and change the laws of a country
