- > Demonstrate how to accept an invitation.







(v.) have a wish or desire to know something


e.g. She wonders if the data presented was correct.

- Excuse me, do you have a minute?
 I have a problem with the file.
- I wonder if you could help me with my weekly report.

You can also use:

- I need some assistance, please.
- I can't manage to do this.
 Can you help?

.:: Offering Help

- ➤ May I help you?
- > I can assist you with that.

Example sentences:

- You seem to have loads of work to finish today.
 May I help you?
- I can see you're struggling with your task.
 I can assist you with that.

You can also use:

- Do you need some help?
- What can I do for you?
- How can I help?

How to Properly Ask for Help



Explain the situation.

Explain what happened so that they can figure out how to help.



Be specific.

Clarify what you need to get the right kind of help.



Consider the timing.

Avoid asking for help at the last minute or odd times of the day.



Show appreciation.

Praise them and be thankful for their help.
