



e.g. We always refer to the team's shared folder to share the same content.

... Giving Suggestions on Avoiding Similar Mistakes

- You can + verb...

Example sentences:

- You can keep the files in a separate folder.

Configure the Permission Settings

This allows you to grant or deny file access to other users.



Hide Your Files

This allows your files to be inaccessible unless you unhide them.



Password-Protect Your Files Using a Third-Party Software Program

This method also protects your data from spyware, viruses, and other kinds of malware.



Secure Your Files Via the Command Prompt

This method denies other users from deleting your file and restricts them from viewing it.
