
▶ Kenzo is at the bank to exchange money and to withdraw some cash.

e.g. The exchange rate is likely to fall in the near future.



transaction

(n.) a time when money is exchanged or the activity of buying or selling something

e.g. The bank has a fixed rate for each transaction.



withdraw

(v.) to take money out of an account

e.g. I must withdraw some money from the bank.

- large bills
 Large bills in Dollars
 are usually \$20-\$100 bills.
