- One of my *closest friends* is getting married this weekend.









- She had *plastic surgery* on her nose to straighten it.

- If you are the *principal cardholder* then you are entitled to get discount prices.




- Girls tend to do better academically in *single-sex schools* than *co-educational* ones.

- I hate to go home during *rush hour*. There's always traffic jam.






- A late excuse relating to heavy *traffic* is not normally accepted.

- He has been teaching *yoga* full time for six years.





- The children were *lucky* to survive the fire which destroyed their home.


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- The government is taking steps to combat *racism* in schools.

- He claims that *prejudice* against homosexuals would cease overnight.








- The reality is that they are condemned to a lifetime of poverty by an inescapable burden of *debt*.
