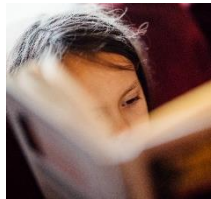

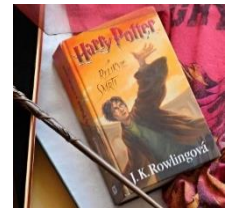

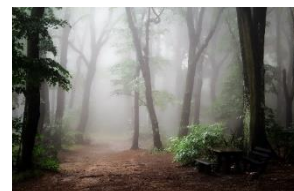
1. **Freezing** weather strands 2000 passengers at Paris airport.
