



Phases of Project Management



Learning Goals

Identify which phase of project management is being described.

1. It indicates the end of the project after the final delivery.
2. In this stage, you need to develop a business case and define the project on a broad level.
3. Project managers make sure that no one deviates from the original plan by establishing CSF and KPI.
4. At this time, roles and responsibilities are clearly defined, so everyone involved knows what they are accountable for.
5. In this phase, the primary tasks are identifying technical requirements, developing a detailed project schedule, creating a communication plan and setting up goals/ deliverables.
