# HABAL-HABAL

One of the most famous yet odd modes of transportation is the Habal-habal. It's a regular motorbike used as public transportation and can carry from 2 to 4 passengers! # **JEEPNEY**

: Philippine jitney bus converted from a jeep.



A Jeepney is definitely considered the face of Filipino transportation, it earned its name as the national vehicle of the country. They were originally made from the US military jeeps remaining from World War II which were later decorated with piquant hues, plastic fringes, upholstered seating and they usually have an iconic horse at its forefront. It is considered the least expensive mode of transportation in the Philippines and can accommodate 20 to 30 people. To locate and board the jeepney, you can either go to its terminal or flag down one as it passes by. If you're not in a boarding area, then unfortunately you may be passed by and unable to board. Some areas are restricted by law to board passengers and therefore Jeepney drivers won't risk picking you up. Passengers sit in very close proximity and look face to face, especially when its full. As you arrive at your destination, tap a coin on its metal rail repeatedly while politely showing your face to your fellow commuters.

# TRICYCLE

: a vehicle similar to a bicycle, but having three wheels, two at the back and one at the front



The tricycle is another very popular mode of transportation and that is evident as you travel around the city. In Cebu, you can find the tricycle almost everywhere other than major highways and the city center. It is comprised of a motorbike and a sidecar which can safely accommodate up to four or five passengers but often can be seen with six or seven commuters. Its sidecar may vary in style and it can also load luggage safely on the roof. Like a jeepney, you can catch them in small terminals while it's waiting to be fully occupied. It can also be the best bargain for family and friends to reach destinations like the beach safely. In Cebu the tricycle can be one of the most reasonable options for traveling around safely and cheaply.

This public vehicle is the bicycle version of the tricycle but the only difference is it is powered fully by a person and not by a motor. The word "sikad" means kick in the Cebuano dialects, thus, trisikad is a three-wheeled transportation which is powered by "kicking" or pedaling the bicycle. This vehicle can accommodate up to four people, which is three in the sidecar and one behind the driver and closely resembles the tricycle. Apart from its cheap fare, it is also eco-friendly since the vehicle has no motor and produces no carbon. Usually, you can see the drivers frolicking in the parks, street corners, and villages. They typically can only transport commuters to destinations that are within one kilometer. Trisikad drivers are usually very polite, welcoming you with a warm smile before welcoming you aboard their humble vehicle and taking you to your destination.
