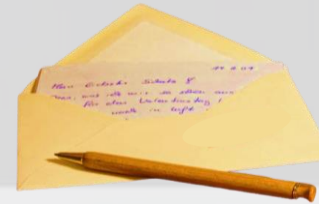

We use “he” when we talk about a **man** or a **boy**.



Is **he** playing soccer?

Yes, **he** is.



Is **he** eating dinner?

Yes, **he** is.

We use “his” to say that **something belongs to a man or a boy.**



What is **he** doing?

**He** is playing with **his** dog.



What is **he** doing?

**He** is brushing **his** teeth.





## Verbs

**Verbs** are action words.



(write)

He is **writing** a letter.



(listen)

I am **listening to** music.



(speak)

I am **speaking with**  
my mom.

write  
draw

## Intransitive verbs

listen  
sit  
talk  
speak



**Note:** Some verbs can be transitive or intransitive in different cases.





## transitive verbs

These are verbs that **have an object** right after them.

transitive  
verb

+

object

drink

coffee

read

a book

watch

TV

speak

Japanese

Examples:

1. The man is **drinking** coffee.
2. You are **reading** a book.
3. They are **watching** TV.
4. I am **speaking** Japanese.

## intransitive verbs

These are verbs that **do not** have an object right after them.

**intransitive  
verb**

+

**preposition**

+

**object**

listen

to

music

speak

with

my mom

think

about

my job

sit

on

a chair

**Examples:**

1. He is **listening to** music.
2. I am **speaking with** my mom.
3. I am **thinking about** my job.
4. She is **sitting on** a chair.
