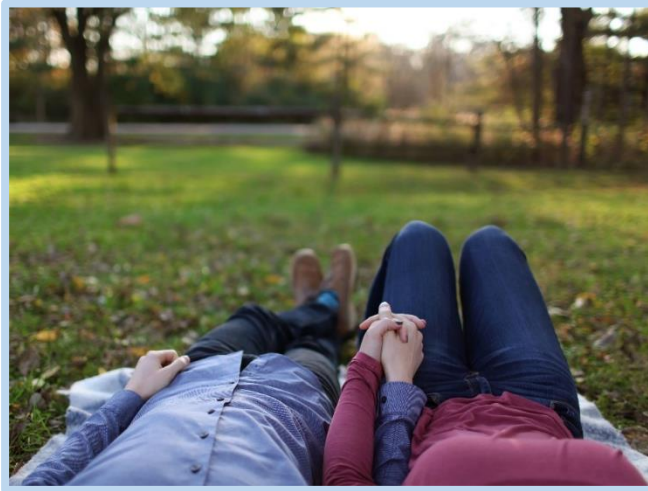

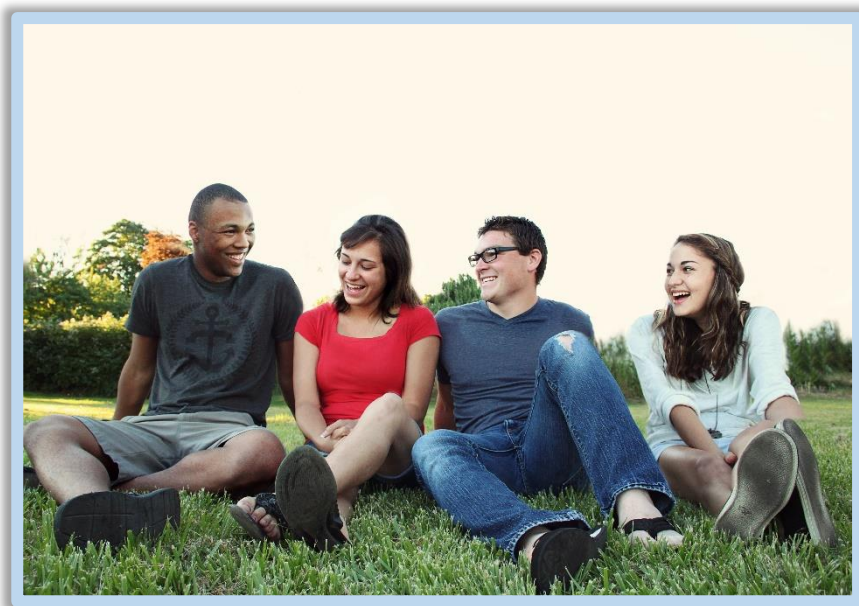

e.g. run - running

verbs ending in -e

remove -e

and add -ing

e.g. make - **making**

4

verbs ending in -ie

change -ie into -y

and add -ing

e.g. lie - **lying**
