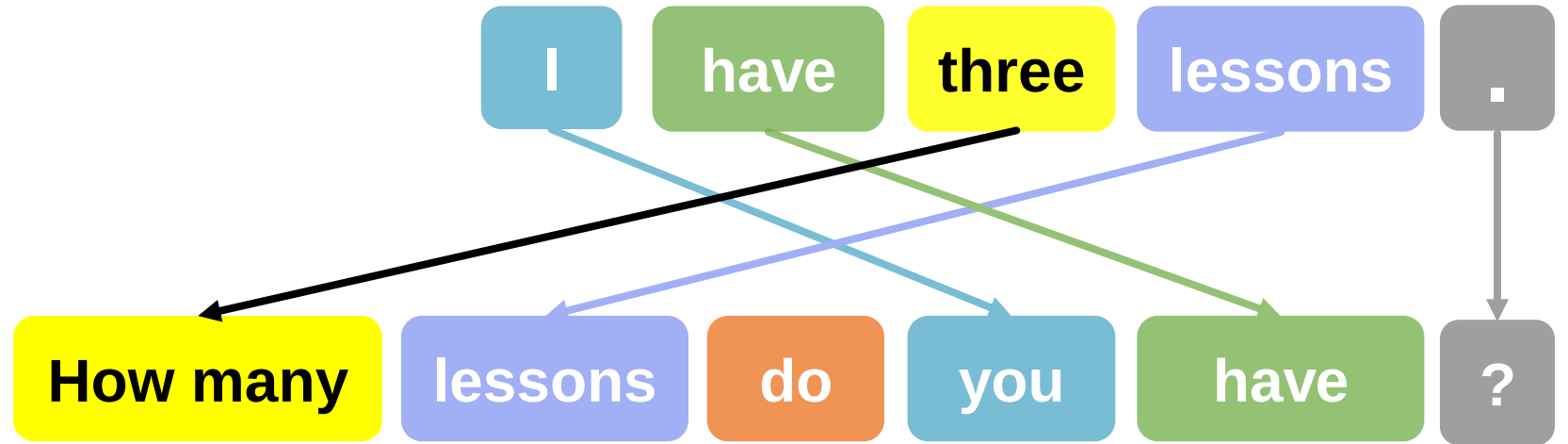

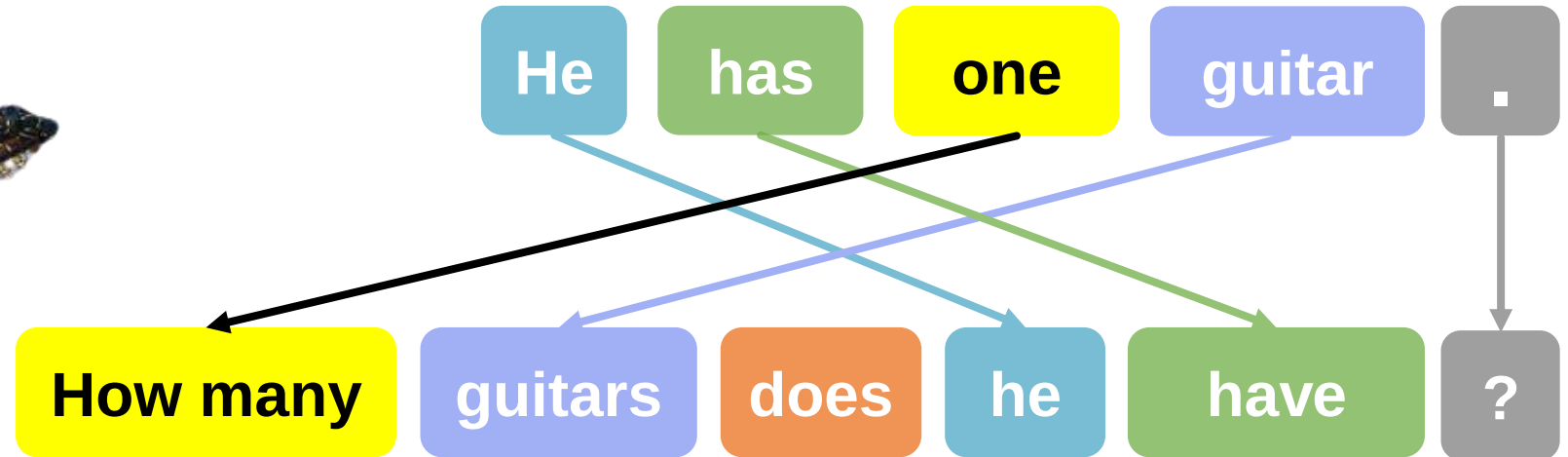
**Note:** “How many” is used to ask about the number of something.

# Pattern

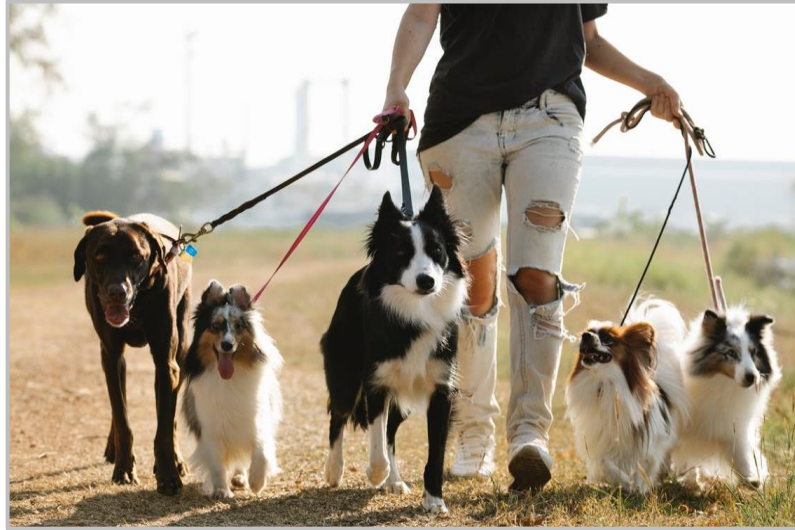
He has ... → How many ... does he have?
