

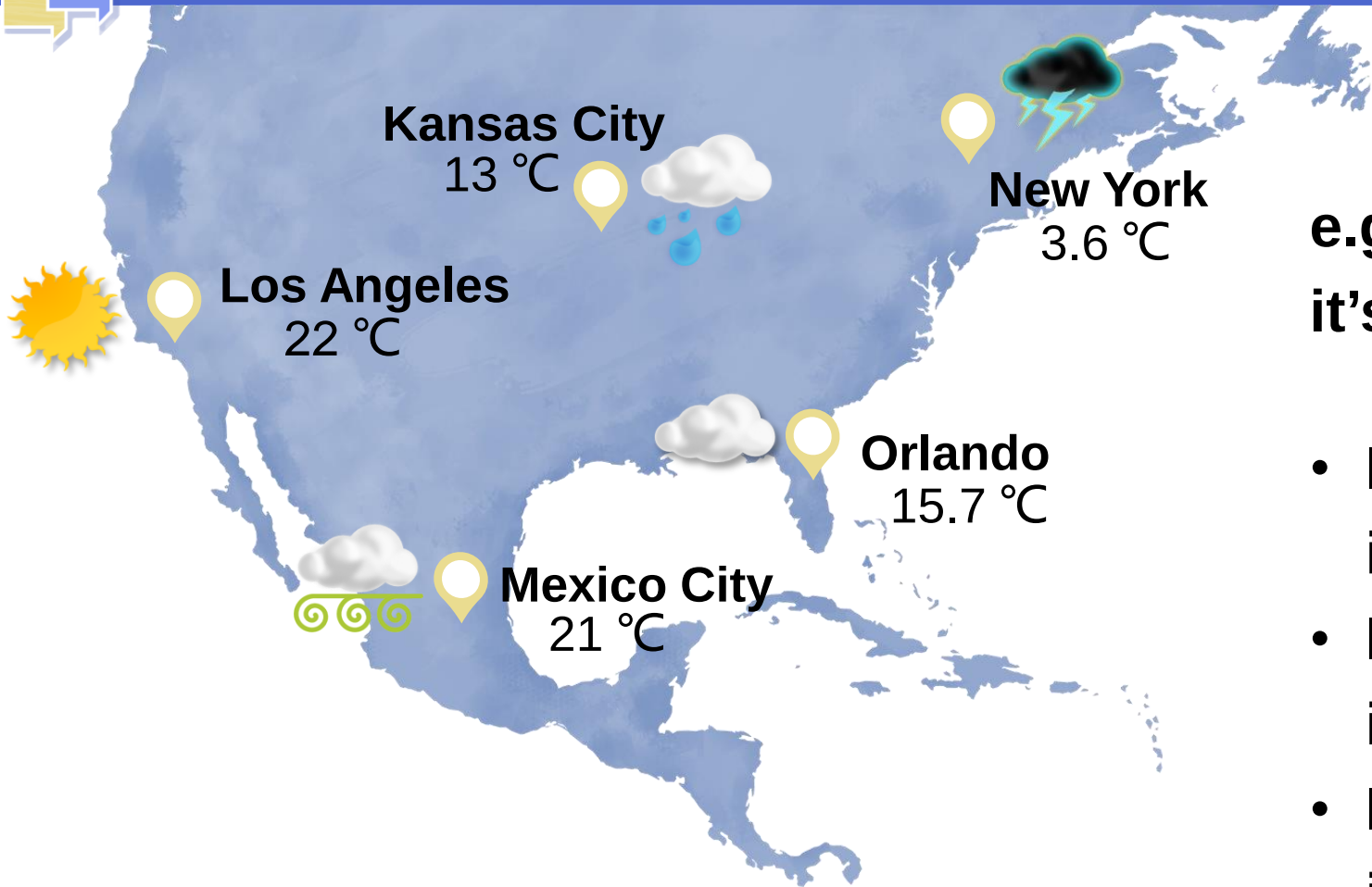

I **am also** eating a peach.

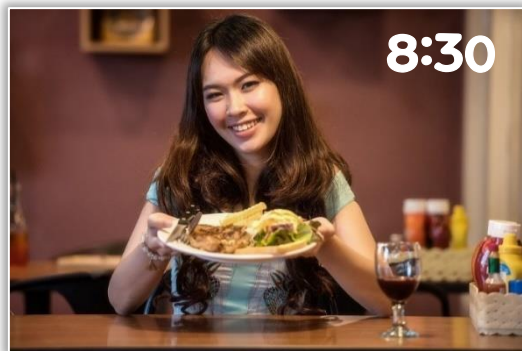

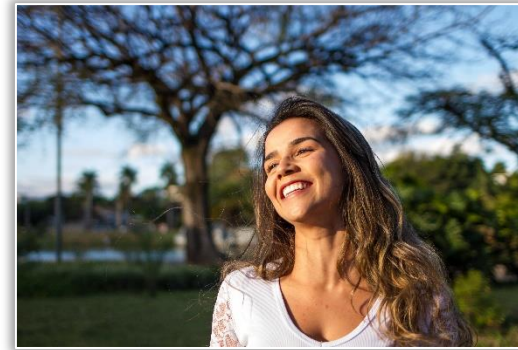

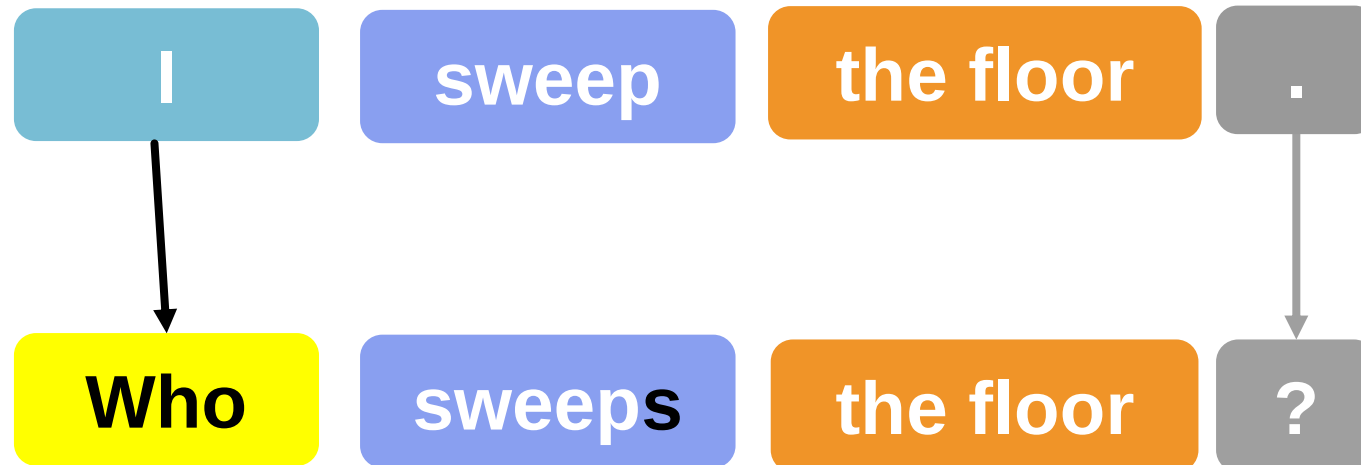
